- 1. Students may not work more than one hundred ninety-two verifiable hours per month.** Reg. 17-8 (a)
- Students must have the Milady's Standard Professional Barbering 6th Edition textbook and receive a minimum of one-hour text book instruction per day provided by the instructor. Reg. 17-8 (c)
- The instructor must have the student's test results for the end of each chapter of the textbook for review by an inspector or audit. Reg. 17-8 (c)
- Monthly reports are due by the 10th of each month. Reg. 17-11
- The instructor must provide the student with a copy of this document each month. Reg. 17- 11
- The instructor must keep a copy of this document and daily sign-in sheet in the shop available for inspection. Reg. 17- 14 (g)
- The instructor must ensure the student has a valid permit, for the above barber shop, posted at their work station with the student's picture is on it. Reg. 17-8 (b)
- The instructor must not leave a student unsupervised in a Barber shop.** Reg. 17-8 (a)
- The instructor must provide the Board with a transcript that breaks down all subjects taught at the end of 1500 hours. Once the 1500 hours are met, the student permit should be returned to this office & the student must register with the testing service provider for the exam & a one-time **non-renewable** 90-day work permit. Reg. 17-11
- The instructor may not train more than 20 students per instructor at any one time. Statute. 17-14
- The instructor is fully responsible to see that all of the above is followed and will be subject to a \$500 penalty per violation.
- All Blanks must be completed.
