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# SPONSOR'S/LANDOWNER'S WEEKLY INSPECTION CHECKLIST

### SC Amusement Ride Safety Code 41-18-80 (G):

Each sponsor/landowner of a fair or carnival or their designees, upon which the fair or carnival is located, must make a visual inspection of each amusement device at least once each week during the period the fair or carnival is operating. \*The director shall provide a checklist for this inspection. If an unsafe amusement device or condition is discovered, it must be immediately reported to the director.

## The following items must be checked:

- 1. Entrance/exit ramps, fencing and barricades.
- 2. Adequate lighting
- 3. Midway tripping or electrical hazards.
- 4. Fuel storage facilities for leaks.
- 5. Fire extinguishers present.
- 6. Required communication equipment is operating.

IN ADDITION TO THE ABOVE, IT IS THE SPONSOR/LANDOWNER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO SEE THAT THE OWNER OF THE AMUSEMENT DEVICE IS PERFORMING THE REQUIRED DAILY INSPECTION PRIOR TO CARRYING PASSENGERS.
